



FIRST ANNUAL TLTF TRUSTEE MEETING REPORT

On Thursday evening, October 28, Paul Knopf (Incline Village NV), Franco Bottley (Longwood FL), and Robert Witt (Austin TX), with wife, Debbie, flew to Indianapolis for the first annual meeting of the TLTF Board of Trustees, and for their first face-to-face meeting after eight months of meetings via Webex. Between then and the end of the meeting Sunday noon, TLTF Elders Bob Maffit, Bob Keck, Jim Murray, and Greg and Linda Rogers also attended the meeting.

On Thursday evening we enjoyed lively conversation during dinner and for a little while afterward at the hotel conference room, after which we closed with fervent prayer. Each morning we opened with prayer, manifestations, and a teaching. In the manifestations, God said that though there is much discouragement in the world, He would encourage us so that we could encourage others.

Then we spent the rest of each day and night discussing a myriad of topics, including: outreach—at home and abroad (translations), campus outreach, website development, staff personnel—both paid and volunteer, building and caring for our base of contributors, financial planning and budgeting (expense percentages of projected revenues), marketing, an online store, a 2012 family conference, and e-publishing and selling the books that John has co-authored, two of which will be updated as time allows.

On Saturday night those of our 25 elders who could joined us, some in person and some on a Webex hookup, for a spirited two-hour discussion of the Strategic Plan we are putting together. Thank God for such technology!

The two primary projects that the Board has directed John to focus on (as his time allows while doing his SAT prep business until we can afford to pay him a salary) are the Foundational Class we will produce, and writing the book on the Administrations in Scripture. By the way, we need an inspired title for each of those monumental presentations—“Anyone, anyone?” There was *much* discussion during the weekend (including the Saturday night hookup) about the foundational class, tentatively slated for filming the last week of May, as we believe having such

a tool is vital to both the outreach of the Word and the unity of those associated with TLTF. And given that we know of no book that adequately covers the critical topic of the Administrations in Scripture, that is also a must-do project.

Franco Bottley reported that we have had about 5300 different people visit our website, and that, among others, we have had 1950 clicks from Tokyo, 1312 from Moscow, and 279 from Beijing. Franco stayed a couple days after the Trustee meeting and set up a different video camera (we returned the much more expensive one we had tried out), so John has since made a number of new YouTube and Vimeo teachings.

Franco (*Christian Battle Tactics*) and Robert (*The Book of Ruth: The Importance of Knowing God's Word*) were able to stay after the meeting and record their teachings before they flew home, and both are now on our Vimeo channel. Paul did an excellent teaching on the Saturday night Webex hookup titled *How You Spend Your Life*, which he will try to record at some point.
